Like I said before, the majority of these two dialects are the same, and roughly about 30 percent that are different. When someone said he/she is **Hmong Daw**, it means he/she speaks the Hmong Daw dialect. **Daw** = Hmong Daw, and **Leng** = Hmong Leng below.

Notice that the *Mong Leng* dialect does not have the *nasal-aspirated* consonants, i.e., <u>H</u>mong is **Mong**, and <u>h</u>nub is **nub** etc... My youngest son one time said, "**Yawm txiv moog dloctor lawm**."
